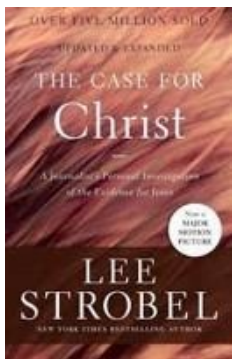

and see how it might inform our own faith walk.

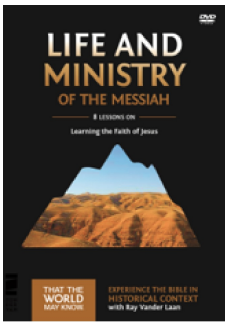

**Adult Studies on Sunday Morning 9:00am** This year we are bringing back adult Bible study on Sunday morning starting September 12th. Our first set of sessions will take a look at the Life and Ministry of the Messiah using materials from That the World May Know. Each session will begin with a video presentation from teacher Ray VanderLaan filmed on location in the Holy Land. Using a mixture of geography, history, archeology, and

**Facility Update** At the congregational meeting held September 19, 2021 the desire to own a facility was affirmed, the property at 170 West Davis affirmed as a place of interest, a negotiating team appointed, and financial parameters approved for that negotiation. That same evening a bid was presented. On Monday September 20 we were informed that the bid of \$241,000.00 with occupancy in sixty days was accepted. Since that offer fell within the approved parameters there will be no need for an additional vote to finalize the agreement.

Steps are now being taken and many additional steps put in place over the next 60 days to get everything in place to finalize that sale and prepare to start the renovation process. Until that time the facility remains the property of the current owner. Please respect that ownership and also understand we can not do anything physically on that property without the owner's permission until the sale is closed.
