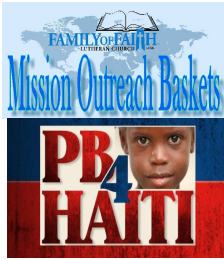

**Communion Assistants** for March are Dan & Lynn Miller.

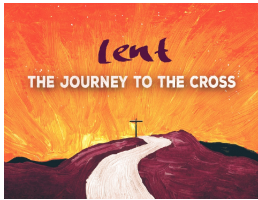
