Communion Assistants for March are Dan & Judy Coppes.

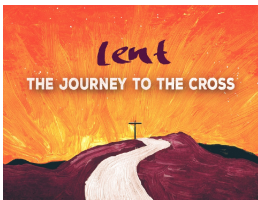

The April Mission Baskets we are collecting monetary donations for Sister in Shelter.



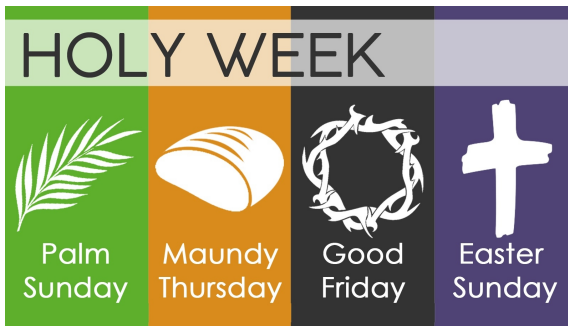

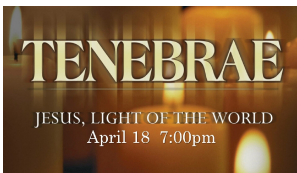

Holy Week traces the last steps climaxing with Easter begin with Palm Sunday on April 13th. Service will be at the mall facility at 10:15am.



Maundy Thursday commemorates the Last Supper and the arrest of Jesus. There will be worship with communion on April 17th at 7:00pm in the mall facility followed immediately with the traditions stripping of the altar and worship area in preparation for Good Friday.



Good Friday at Family of Faith will be Tenebrae, the historic worship of candles and darkness. The service this year will feature the reading of Christ's Passion from the Gospel of Mark along with music and reflection time between readings. Service is Friday April 18th at 7:00pm in the mall facility.



Celebration of Easter will be Sunday April 20th at 10:15 in the mall facility. Please invite family and friends to join us. Our choir has been working on a special anthem and we will have a resurrection message based on Mark 16: 1-11.
