Welcome and Announcements

P: Who are we who gather here today and come singing the praises of God? C: We are seekers in need of grace and sinners saved by grace.

P: By what justification do we come into the presence of God where only the righteous can stand?

C: We do not believe that we can be justified before God by our own strength, merit, or works but are freely justified for Christ's sake through faith when we believe we are received into grace and our sins are forgiven on account of Christ, who by his death made satisfaction for our sins. This faith God imputes for righteousness in his sight.

P: Why do we gather?

C: To mature in faith and give thanks to the one who gives us this gift of grace. In order that we may obtain this faith and grow into it, the ministry of teaching the Gospel and administering the sacraments was instituted. For through the Word and the sacraments, as through instruments, the Holy Spirit is given, and the Holy Spirit produces faith, where and when it pleases God, in those who hear the Gospel.

P: For what are we being prepared?

C: We believe that this faith is bound to bring forth good fruits and that it is necessary to do the good works commanded by God. We must do so because it is God's will and not because we rely on such works to merit justification before God. For forgiveness of sins and justification are apprehended by faith.

P: But have we not fallen short of that purpose?

C: We have and therefore we must repent. Properly speaking repentance consists of these two parts: one is contrition - that is terror smiting the conscience with a knowledge of sin; and the other is faith, which is born of the Gospel communicated as absolution that sins are forgiven for Christ's sake. This comforts the conscience and delivers it from terror. Then good works, which are the fruit of repentance, are bound to follow.

All: Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for (Ephesians 3:20-21) ever and ever! Amen
