

Vision Team Highlights

•Pastor's Report - Pastor Phil: Health Update - Pastor Phil is doing well since his hospital stay and has been working from home.

2025-2026 Preaching/Teaching Plan: Pastor Phil distributed his preaching/teaching plan (sermon text, topic and teaching text) starting November 30.

•Finance - Mike Cholodewitsch: Mike reported on the checking account and building fund.

Construction Loan Status: the funds from the construction loan to the conventional loan have not been moved. The conventional loan will have to pay principal and interest.

Fund Recovery: We may be reimbursed for some of our extra expenses. Because the HVAC system has not been received/installed, we have placed heaters around the refurbished area. We are hoping for fund recovery.

An extra title search has to be performed.

•Facilities - Tom Nahm: Sewer Line: Randy reported that Chris Theis said that there is a leak and we need to find someone else to do the work. There are also tree roots in the line. The sewer line is our problem.

Fire System and Monitoring: There is a monitoring company in Forest, Ohio, and one of their employees lives in Tiffin. This company would be easier to work with. By law if there is a fire, the fire department will be notified.

Exterior Painting and Landscaping: The exterior paint is purchased and a member will be doing the painting, but will have to wait until 5 Star is done and the weather cooperates. The weeds have been sprayed.

• Worship - Kathy Falter: Kathy reported that everything is going well.

Randy thanked Kathy for stepping up and planning last week's service.

There will be a Thanks giving Eve service at First Christian.

Where can we hold our Christmas Eve service? Pastor Phil will check into this; we do have options.

•Spiritual Development - Melissa Jameson: Melissa said that Sunday School is going great. The room is cleaned before and after each class. The classes have been combined and there are now three teachers (Julie is now helping).

Women of Faith: and our next meeting will be at Zo Redman's on December 30.

• Congregational Care - Dave Murray: Dave reported that he has enough volunteers to help at the Sharing Kitchen on November 24.

Also, the shut-ins are being visited each month. Christmas cards will be sent to the shut-ins next month.

- Outreach Julie Engle: Julie reported that the Samaritan's Purse Christmas boxes need to be returned next Sunday and the gifts from the Angel Tree for the Salvation Army need to be returned by November 30.
- Volunteer Coordination/President's Report Randy Schwartz: Randy reported that he is still working on finding new committee chairs for next year.

• Other Business: Exterior Lighting: the electrical system has been in place for the exterior lighting to tie into.
