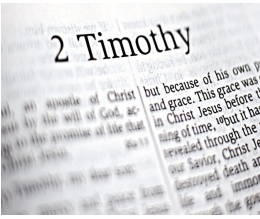
Communion Assistants for May are: Jeff Shuey and Jim Vassar.
